3. What details do you find most striking from the final Servant Song (52:13–53:12)? Why?
4. What can we learn about Jesus from that final song?

### **REFLECTING ON THE TEXT**

1. Christ's redeeming work isn't limited by ethnic or social boundaries. What impact does that have in calling others to repentance and faith?
2. What can we learn about God from the doctrine of substitutionary atonement?
3. If you are a believer, Christ bore your punishment on the cross. How does that affect the way you think about temptation and sin?
4. How does Christ's fulfillment of the prophecies in Isaiah 53 affirm and defend the authority and inerrancy of God's Word?

### **PERSONAL RESPONSE**

1. What steps can you take this week to help bring the gospel message to all people?
2. What are some ways you can express your thanks and appreciation to Jesus for all He has done for you?
